SOCIAL EDUCATION

- Tutor or mentor as the internal referent
- Social and educative generalists actions dressed to the whole population
- Group activities
- Animation
- Project EUREKA

(1) ARTS

- Framework Program of Fine Art, Audiovisual and Scenic's
- Monitors belonging to the Department of Justice
- Communitarian dimension
- Supporting entities/organizations

(2) ARTS

- Specialties audio-visual: radio, video, photography
- Visual and Scenic's: music, theater
- Fine Arts: Painting and Illustration, Ceramic, Sculpture, Binding, Design and Recycling, Papier mâché, Installations...

(3) ARTS

- Community Projection: Competitions, exhibitions, tradeshows
- Prison art competition's in prison or in public and / or private external places
- Diversity, Association of Ceramistes de Catalunya, Poble Espanyol, Music competitions, Binding exhibition, Moncunill and Marraco (Prix)
- Circular to standardize sales and income works to the inmates: 50% for the inmate, 50% for the workshop.
- Each specialty has its competition and its external showing space
- Each center, in conjunction with the SECE, use to organize some of these competition and exhibitions

Libraries

- Each center has a central library and several reading rooms
- Agreement with the Department of Culture with the aim to modernize the prison library system
- Agreements with publishers to improve library bibliographic funds
- Daily press: newspapers and magazines
- International Press Service

SPORTS AREA

- Monitors and / or sport professionals in all prisons
- Agreements with organizations and sports federations
- Public tender for the provision of sporting services (not structural)
- Organization of internal competitions
- Championships and participation in external events
- Conventions for the donation of sports equipment

EUREKA PROJECT

- Education Project at leisure and free time mostly on weekends
- Funded by the Federation of Social Foundations from banks
- 14 entities engaged in activities, workshops, training, performances in different prisons.
- Intercultural music, classical music, radio, magic, chess, circus, theater, dance, social theater, playroom, battery of activities, etc ...
