- >Ressources to do the documentary research: records/cards to be filled by the inmates, educational materials, training and advice (by the Institute for Private Studies Jewish World)
- >Activity regulated by the multidisciplinary teams of both penitentiary centres according to the PIT (individual treatment project) designed for each of them.
